<p>The Denver Art Museum Audio Visual Department offers excellent on-site services for events at the museum. We are here to assist with all the AV aspects of your event. Our equipment includes state-of-the-art integrated AV systems as well as a variety of portable options. Our AV staff is trained to operate all equipment listed and is here to offer technical assistance whenever it is needed.</p> <p>Please note that most events will require at least one AV Operator for the duration of the entire event (not simply the AV portion of the program). Duration of AV service for each event includes set-up time, operating equipment during the program, as well as striking and re-setting equipment time at the end of your event. AV staff is available to remain on-site for all these activities to serve needs as they arise. Complex events may require additional AV staff and will be billed accordingly. In some cases, the on-site DAM staff coordinator for your event will be able to operate the equipment at no additional charge. If so, AV charges will only be incurred for equipment used and set-up/strike time.</p> <p>Outside vendors may be contracted to meet AV needs beyond the scope of the museums' offerings. The AV Department can provide you with a list of qualified local companies familiar with the museum. As a rule, outside vendors must operate only their own equipment. Equipment from the museum requires DAM AV staff to operate, and, if needed, to coordinate with your contracted vendor. DAM AV will work with your contracted vendor as needed to ensure a successful outcome.</p>
