School Tour Information Sheet

The DAM offers a wide variety of tours for students in kindergarten through college. All school tours address Colorado Model Content Standards (CMCS).

Scheduling Tours

Tours are available Tuesday–Friday, September 16, 2008–May 22, 2009. Space is limited, so please schedule tours at least three weeks in advance (one week for self-guided tours).

To book more than one tour, call the school programs office at 720-913-0075. Monday–Friday, 1–5pm.

Self-guided Visits

Teachers who want to lead their own groups through the museum or special exhibitions must schedule a self-guided visit with the tour coordinator by fax, mail or phone by calling 720-913-0075. Plan self-guided tours for 30 or more students to begin at noon or later.

Self-guided groups must make reservations at least one week in advance and are expected to follow the same rules as guided groups. If your group has more than thirty students, please plan your visit for after 12 pm.

If you plan to have your students do worksheets or sketch, please have them use black pencils and paper 8-1/2 x 11" or smaller. Please do not bring clipboards or pens.

Self-guided tours of the museum's collections are \$3 per student and teachers and adult chaperones are free. For temporary exhibitions, please note fees in the "Temporary Exhibition" section.

Supervision

For tours of the museum's collection, one adult supervisor is required for every 10 students. Temporary exhibition tours require one supervisor for every five students.

Fees

Adult supervisors are admitted free to all tours. See tour descriptions for student fees that are due on the day of your tour. Teachers from Denver Public Schools, please note that the district has prepaid some tours. Please inquire when booking.

Access Services

To arrange for a sign language interpreter, call 720-913-0059 at least one week in advance.

Arriving for Your Tour

Groups should arrive 15 minutes before their tour and use our school entrance on 14th Avenue.

If you plan to do worksheets or sketch, bring regular black pencils and notebooks that are 8-1/2" x 11" or smaller. Please do not bring clipboards or pens.

Lunch Facilities

While the museum does not have a lunchroom for groups, students may bring lunches for picnics in Martin/Acoma Plaza or nearby parks.
