Denver Art Museum Cinema Spring 2007 Film Series

To inaugurate its new home in the 266-seat Lewis I. Sharp Auditorium in the Frederic C. Hamilton Building, the Denver Art Museum Cinema is proud to present a special program of seven great Hollywood classics on the big screen. Selected on a decade-by-decade basis from the silent era to the 1980s, these beloved films include *The Wizard of Oz*, *Casablanca*, *On the Waterfront* and *Tootsie*. The series will kick off with a screening of Buster Keaton's silent comedy masterpiece, *The General*, with piano accompaniment by local favorite Hank Troy.

- May 2 ***The Wild Bunch*** (1969), directed by Sam Peckinpah; starring William Holden, Ernest Borgnine and Robert Ryan. Rated R.
- May 9 ***Jaws*** (1975), directed by Steven Spielberg; starring Roy Scheider, Richard Dreyfuss and Robert Shaw. Rated PG.
- May 16 ***Tootsie*** (1982), directed by Sidney Pollack; starring Dustin Hoffman and Jessica Lange. Rated PG.
